- In the hunt of CBSE Budding Authors, Students from Grade 6-8 have been selected for both, English as well as Hindi reading and comprehending for writing their own stories from the same.
- CBSE Child rights competition was conducted on February 2nd week. Students had participated, answered the questionnaire and they have received online certificate.
